Dear Parents/Caregivers
Welcome back everyone.

During the holidays it was announced that we have been given an extra Staff Development Day on **Monday 19th December** for professional learning to assist in the implementation of new syllabus. This means students will now finish the year on **Friday 16th December**.

Attached to today's newsletter is some information from Road Safety NSW Transport on children passing a five-step test before moving to an adult seatbelt. Please read carefully.

This term we have two full-day **2023 Kindergarten Orientation Days**. The dates are listed in the **Dates to Note** on the side of the front page of the newsletter. Please pass these dates onto anyone you know who may be starting school in 2023.

The NSW Government has recently changed Covid restrictions, which will come into effect on 14th October. We know that Covid is still in our community. We ask that you please monitor your child for symptoms, have them tested, and keep them home until they are symptom free. Please also monitor for cold/flu symptoms. We had several students at school yesterday with colds and coughs. To ensure we keep staff and students well, and our school operating to maximum levels, we ask that any student with cold/flu/coughs be kept home from school until they are symptom-free. We will continue to ring you if your child becomes sick at school and present to the sick bay area and our First Aid Officer.

If you have plans for an extended holiday during term time, you need to complete an application. Please ask at the front office for this application if needed.

Before you move your child to an adult seatbelt they must pass this five-step test



1

Sit upright with their back against the seat



2

Bend their knees over the edge of the seat



3

Sit with the sash belt across their mid-shoulder



4

Sit with the lap belt across the top of their thighs



5

Remain in this position for the whole trip
